Background

In 2011 I studied Certificate in New Media Creation at Dumfries and Galloway College after knowing I wished to further my interests in creative media, initially sparked from having enjoyed Art and Design at Dumfries High School.

The following academic year I studied the HNC Photography programme. In this course I learned about more advanced photographic techniques such as working in a studio environment with professional lighting equipment, backdrops and DSLR camera gear. I undertook various projects including studio and location based portraiture, studio still life projects, photojournalism, analogue photography projects and applied techniques. I completed my HNC Photography year with a final, self-written brief, Graded Unit, which I chose to focus on Automotive photography. I achieved an A grade, producing a selection of high quality images.

Upon achieving the grade, I was accepted to continue the next part of the Photography programme, advancing to the HND level. I have since completed the course, in which architecture, stock, documentary, fashion, advertising and DSLR moving image projects featured. For my HND Graded Unit I undertook a self-written brief using DSLR moving image and timelapse photography technique. I achieved an A grade for the resulting six minute film I produced.

My Skills

My photographic skills and knowledge have advanced dramatically since starting the HNC course. I understand the fundamentals of photography and I am constantly expanding my knowledge and skills of more advanced techniques such as implementing artificial and supplementary lighting. I can work with monochrome analogue media including developing and printing. Experience with various projects on the college courses means I can work to specific briefs and achieve high quality imagery that can be delivered to tight deadlines. I am always keen to experiment and I push my photography regularly by taking on more complex projects which require advanced technique.

At this time I do not feel that I wish to settle on a specific area of photography though I feel I am working towards developing a creative commercial style. Recently I have been adapting my shooting style and workflow towards digital moving imagery. Videography is where the current commercial imaging market is heading towards so I feel it sensible to explore this area in greater detail.

I am competent using 35mm format digital and film SLR cameras, owning a Canon DSLR myself with a variety of lenses from ultra wide angle to telephoto, I have supporting accessories such as Neutral Density and Polarising filters, a flash and a tripod. I have experience using the following cameras:

I am also competent in High Definition Videography using DSLR cameras. I have a small amount of equipment dedicated for producing professional looking moving imagery such as a slider and jib. I also have a basic shotgun microphone.

I have experience using Bowens and Elinchrom studio and location lighting kits.

I am proficient in working with Adobe Photoshop CS5, CS6 and CC. I am currently learning how to use Adobe Lightroom 5. I always working with RAW image formats and working through manipulation processes as necessary. I can use both Apple Macintosh and PC based platforms. I tend to perform image adjustments in post-production software only where necessary, however, aiming to achieve the image as correct as possible in camera by ensuring exposure and any supplemental lighting is correct.

For video purposes I have experience using Non Linear Editing platforms and have completed a project using the video features in Adobe Photoshop CS6. I have had experience editing video using Final Cut Pro 7 alongside plug-ins such as MPEG Streamclip and PluralEyes. I am now working to educate myself on using Adobe Premiere Pro, After Effects and SpeedGrade.
